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## INFORMATION FOR FUNDERS

### **The Vaccine**



The administration of the Johnson & Johnson preferred single dose vaccine, is temporarily on hold whilst regulators investigate a possible link to unusual blood clotting. Government has also procured 30 million doses of the Pfizer vaccine which is a double-dose vaccine.

### **Procurement**



Government remains the SOLE purchaser and distributor of the vaccine.

Private providers will be appointed and vetted by government.

### **Vaccination sites**



Sites will be allocated based on proximity and could include pharmacies, GPs and work-based sites, in addition to hospitals and clinics.

### **Registration**



All SA residents can register on the Electronic Vaccine Data System (EVDS) from 16<sup>th</sup> April, roll-out will still be according to the stipulated phases. Phase 1, namely healthcare workers, is ongoing. Phase 2 is targeted to commence on 17<sup>th</sup> May and will be essential workers under 60 with co-morbidities, people over 60 and those living in communal settings. Phase 3 will be the remaining population and is targeted to begin on the 17<sup>th</sup> October. Register on:

### **Reimbursement**



SEP of the vaccine is still to be confirmed. Government will reimburse private providers for vaccines given to the un-insured.
