MOTO HEALTH CARE PRIVACY POLICY



Moto Health Care Medical Scheme (MHC/ we, us, our) complies with the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (POPIA); and is committed to protecting your privacy and takes its responsibilities regarding the protection and security of personal information very seriously. The purpose of this privacy policy is to explain how MHC collects, uses, shares, protects, and stores your personal information. The registered Scheme Rules of MHC will apply if there is any conflict between the Rules and a provision of this Policy.



POPIA defines Personal information as information that relates to an identifiable, living natural person, and where it is applicable to an identifiable existing juristic person. Examples would be any information that identifies or relates specifically to you and your dependants, if applicable, such as:

- your name, age, identity number, contact details, gender, marital status; sexual orientation, disability, religion, culture
- · your education or medical, financial, criminal or employment history
- any identifying number, symbol, email address, physical address, telephone number, online identifier
- biometric information
- information you use to register on the website and banking details.



HOW DOES MHC COLLECT AND USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

We will collect personal information from you (the data subject), your employer or from our contracted brokers. We may also, where necessary collect personal information from third parties. Examples of how we collect personal information include, when you use the website, complete an application form, or contact us electronically. By doing the abovementioned, you understand that you are entrusting us with yours and your family's personal information and in some cases, your employees.

When you are providing personal information for a child (person under 18 years of age) you confirm that you are a competent person and have the authority to provide consent on their behalf.

Your privacy is important to us, so we will only disclose, collate and process ("use") your personal information with your express written permission, unless we are legally permitted or required to do so.

We will not use your personal information for any other purpose, other than that which we disclose to you, unless you give us your express written permission to do so or unless we are permitted or required to do so by law.

We will not sell or provide your personal information to unauthorised third parties for their independent use without your consent.

By using our website to register or apply online for any of our products or services, or to contact us electronically, including through social media, you provide MHC with your express written permission to use your personal information with our service providers, in the ordinary course of our business, including the purpose of providing you with the relevant products and services. You may revoke this consent in writing at any time. Should you revoke this consent, we will only be able to share your information with our service providers, as permitted in terms of the law or in a de-identified manner. MHC collects your personal information for, amongst others, the following reasons, namely to:

- process your instructions or requests;
- provide you with the relevant products and services;
- to personalise and tailor our services to meet your needs;
- effectively administer your benefit option;
- collect and analyse your personal information and combine all the information that we have about you for research and statistical purposes.
- send you promotional material or details, which we think may be of interest to you once we have collected and analysed your personal information; and
- · conduct market research.



We shall take all reasonable steps, including the implementation of appropriate security safeguards, to protect the privacy and confidentiality of your personal information from loss, misuse or unauthorised alteration. All the personal information is stored in databases that have built-in safeguards, for example on MHC's secured servers, which are located in protected centres at contracted third parties or MHC premises.

If you use the website, you must keep your access details (including your username and password, if applicable), confidential and not allow other people to use them. You accept full responsibility for all activities that occur under your access details or password and accept responsibility for sharing your username and password. You also agree that any use of your access details shall be regarded as if you were the person using such information. We shall take reasonable steps to ensure that our service providers, who have access to your and your dependants' personal information, if applicable, keep such information confidential.

We are not responsible for any representations, information, warranties or content on any third-party website (including any third-party website linked to this website. We do not exercise control over the privacy policies of these third parties and you should refer to their privacy policies for details of how your privacy is protected.



Should you wish to update, correct or delete any personal information held by us, you can **e-mail us on info@mhcmf.co.za** or contact client services by **calling 0861 000 300.** In some instances, we may decline your request to delete your personal information, where continued retention is required:

- · by law or
- · for lawful purposes relating to our functions; or
- by a contract between MHC and yourself.

Retention

We will **retain your and your dependants' personal information** as part of its records for as long as it is necessary for achieving the purpose for which the information was collected or subsequently processed, it is required for lawful purposes, as may be required by legislation and for historical, statistical or research purposes, subject to the requirements of the law.

Direct Marketing

If permission is given, we may **use your personal or other information to send you promotional material** or details, which we think may be of interest to you, about products, services and special offers from us or contracted third parties. You can request us to stop sending promotional communication to you at any time.

Amendment of this privacy policy

MHC may in its **sole discretion amend this privacy policy from time to time.** It is recommended that you review this privacy policy statement regularly. The latest version of this privacy policy shall replace and supersede any previous versions.

Jurisdiction

The laws of the Republic of South Africa shall **govern this privacy policy and you consent to the jurisdiction** of the South African courts in respect of any dispute, which may arise from or in connection with the interpretation or application of this privacy policy.

International transfer of your personal information

We will only transfer your personal information to third parties outside South Africa, in any one or more of the following circumstances:

- to a country which has adopted laws similar to POPIA or there is an agreement with the receiving third party;
- to administer certain services, e.g. cloud services;
- where the transfer is necessary in terms of a contract with you or a third party;
- where you have permitted us to do the transfer; and/or
- where we are unable to obtain your consent, and the transfer is in your interest.
